### JUROR

Lenny Moskowitz



Lenny Moskowitz is a Connecticut landscape painter who lives in New Haven. He graduated with his B.F.A. from the Philadelphia College of Art and received his M.F.A. from Michigan's Cranbrook Academy. Lenny has participated in both group and solo shows at numerous galleries throughout the U.S. and has taught classes and workshops in Connecticut, Block Island, and Nantucket. He has been awarded several artist residencies, including at the Anderson Center in Michigan and at the NISDA Foundation on Nantucket, MA, and Weir Farm in Wilton, CT. He makes yearly painting trips to Nantucket, and frequent sojourns to the surrounding the Connecticut woods to paint the landscapes.

In terms of his criteria for judging a show, he says that the artists' skill sets and techniques are important, but equally important is originality! If the subject is familiar, it must be presented in an original way.

The Guilford Art League was founded in 1947 by a small group of local artists. The objective of the art league is to promote and stimulate interest in the visual arts. Members and associates of the Guilford Art League are a participating and interactive group of artists who learn and benefit from their association with one another.



ELIGIBILITY	<b>Open to all Connecticut artists, 18 years or older.</b> Works deemed inappropriate for any reason by GAL will not be accepted. The juror's decisions are final. Work must be ORIGINAL, not created under tutelage and not previously shown at the Art Center.	
IMPORTANT DATES	All media are eligible, including oils, watercolor, pastels, acrylics, sculpture, collage, mixed media, printmaking, and photography. If you use photos for reference, they must be your own photos. Reproductions (giclée prints), crafts, or computer art will not be accepted. No size limit. Not-for-sale work is acceptable. All work must be suitably wired and ready for hanging. No sawtooth hangers or clips. Pedestals can be supplied if needed.	
RECEIVING	Entries should be delivered to the Mill Gallery on <b>Saturday, September 11, 10 am-1 pm</b>	<b>COVID:</b> GAL will follow COVID protocols
RECEPTION	Friday, September 17, 6-8 pm Awards and refreshments	as set by the CDC, the State of Connecticut and Guilford Art Center. Updates on the reception, gallery hours, and COVID restrictions will be available at receiving.
