- If not for sale, works must be marked NFS and must state value for insurance purposes.
- GAC will insure all exhibited works for 50% of the piece's retail value from receiving date to removal date. GAC is not responsible for damage occurring before arrival or after removal or damage during shipping. GAC will not be responsible for any work left past the pick-up date.
